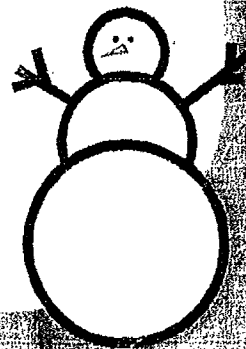

First of all, let me thank you so much for your potential contribution to the Developmental Adolescent Residential Treatment (DART) Program this holiday season! We are a residential treatment program for children ages 8-18 years old with severe developmental and behavioral disorders. Our program works with these children to teach daily living skills, therapeutic coping techniques, and independent living skills as we work to prepare them to live at their highest level of independence. We also provide them with therapeutic and clinical services, assisting them in being successful despite the obstacles they have and potentially will face.

As a residential program, the children we serve live with us full-time, including the holidays. Very few of our children will actually go home for the holidays, let alone see their families. Many of the kids we serve are permanent wards of the Michigan foster care system, meaning the only gifts they receive this year will come from us. This is where we're hoping you will help us. In an effort to give our kids the best Christmas possible, we're asking for donations. Below is a list of supplies to provide our kids things to flourish. Some will be used for activities of daily living groups and other for recreation.

- Headphones
- Markers, Crayons
- Sidewalk chalk
- School supplies: pens, notebooks, simple calculators, pencils, pencil sharpeners, erasers
- Color books, sketch books
- Construction paper
- Batteries (all sizes)
- Baking mixes (muffins, brownies, cookies etc.)
- Snow suits (all sizes)
- Plastic sleds
- Gloves, Hats, Scarves
- Full or Snack size candy
- Hair ties, bows and headbands
